**Answer:**

Assalamu Aleikum,

Is it permissible to work for a muslim (consultant) who has a client that is the Stock Exchange in the region as well as other muslims whose business structure is public ltd - (registered with the stock exchange)?

Answer: It is prohibited and sin to work, trade or to deal with PLC company owned by Muslims. The only advise and consult for them is to transfer their PLC company to a proper Islamic Company.

Is it permissible for a muslim to work for the United Nations in any capacity?

Answer: Yes, It is prohibited to work for the United Nations in any capacity.

If a husband wants more children and the wife does not, how should this be handled?

Answer: There are some choices for example: to have Ihtisaab and Sabr so may Allah (swt) will guide her, or to marry another wife, or to persuade her and try to see if she have got a divine permit because if she reject the right of her husband to have children from her without a divine permit she is sinful and Naashez

Is it permissible to buy milk from a muslim and the individual adds water to the milk?

Answer: If you know for sure, you must advice him, otherwise you must warn people from him because it is haram for Muslim to cheat and it is haram for us to co-operate with him e.g. by buying from him even if you buy a bread.
